Toho Water Authority Headquarters Achieves LEED®Gold Certification

Kissimmee, FL – Toho Water Authority is proud to announce that it has received the LEED (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) Gold certification. Toho is the first government building to receive this Gold certification in Osceola County.

LEED is an internationally recognized green building certification system which promotes a whole-building approach to sustainability by recognizing performance in five key areas: sustainable site development, water savings, energy efficiency, materials selection and indoor environmental quality.

There are four levels of certification that can be awarded by means of a point system for different categories: Certified, Silver, Gold and the highest being Platinum.

“We were originally planned for LEED Silver, but with the help of a dedicated project team, we surpassed our goal to obtain LEED Gold certification” said Annie Geary, Toho’s Project Manager.

The office building on Martin Luther King Blvd. was designed by KZF Design, LLC with construction management by Balfour Beatty Construction and PMA as the Owner’s Representative.

The building houses all of Toho’s administration, engineering, accounting and customer service departments.
